Materials & Tools:

- Bazzil Basics Scallop 12" x 12" card stock
- Turquoise and pink 12" x 12" card stock
- Frosted Shrink Plastic
- White card stock
- Bubbalicious 5" chipboard swirl
- Fine black marker pen
- Scissors
- Paper trimmer
- White acrylic paint
- Double sided tape
- Heat gun (or oven)
- Double sided tape
- Photograph

1. Cut your turquoise and pink card stock pieces down to around 20 x 20cm. Cut them up so that you have alternate colours with small gaps between them. Stick them in the centre of your scallop card stock.



2. Paint your chipboard swirl in the white acrylic paint. Don't worry about painting the edges of the chipboard. Once this is dry, stick it in the bottom left corner using small pieces of double sided tape.



3. Draw out the wings, stars and letters onto the shrink plastic. The wings should be 12cm high, the stars 4cm big and the letters 7cm tall. Cut out the shapes leaving a border. Shrink them as per the instructions on the pack.

4. Cut out strips of white card stock for the remainder of the title. Draw out the words using your black marker. Stick the photograph, title and rest of the shapes in place. Using the black marker draw around the edges of the scalloped card stock.

This techniques can be applied to most scrapbook pages as well as cards and other craft projects.

You can create any shape you like with shrink plastic - if you don't like drawing by hand, you can print pictures from your computer and then trace them through the shrink plastic. You can also add colour to your shapes.
