

## Halloween Goody Box & Treats



### What you will need:

Lauren Meader "Box Template" available [here](#) at Papertrey Ink

Shabby Princess "Holidays" Digi Kit

Brads, buttons, pin, ribbon, black wired cord

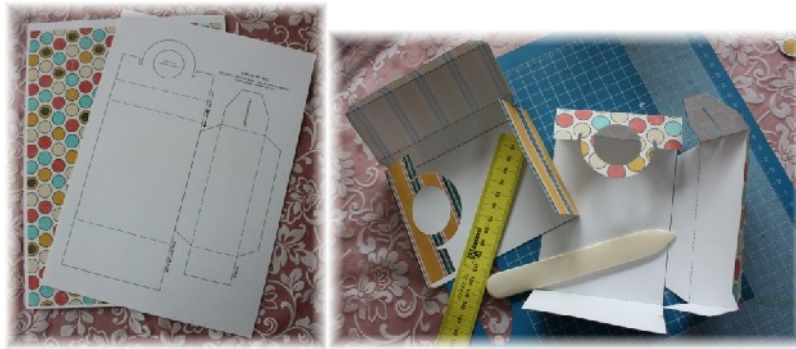
Black card, white tissue paper, fine liner

*Tools:* Computer for sentiments, circle punch, paper trimmer, craft knife, ruler,  
bone folder

## Instructions:

1. Start by printing 2 sheets of patterned paper of your choice. Then insert both sheets back into your printer and print the box template, making sure the template is on the reverse of your sheet. (See below)



2. Using a metal ruler and bone folder, score along specified lines and crease the folds ready for construction. Using a high bond double sided tape construct your box using the instructions provided.



3. Cut a length of paper about an inch thick using the left over's from your patterned papers and attach the "Trick or Treat" sentiment from the kit. Add some ribbon folded once with a brad to secure it into place, repeat this on both sides of the box. Adhere thick foam tape and attach around the rim of your box to give the project dimension.

4. Using the "Halloween Advertisement" mini pictures from the digi kit, cut 2 of your choice, layer them onto black card and attach to your box on both sides.

5. Using "MS Word" create 4 "Happy Halloween" sentiments and create into a circle shape using Word art. For best results use a circle punch to cut these out. Now take two of them and add a button to the centre of each. Attach the sentiment using foam pads so that it slightly overlaps the picture.

\*\*To create the tag I used some co-ordinating ribbon, papers, buttons, pin, and other 2 sentiments and attached them to black wired cord.



## And now for the Yummy bit:

You will need: Smarties boxes, mini bags of Haribo Gummy bears, Lolly pops, tissue paper, ribbon, tape, pics from the digi kit, fine liner



### GHOSTIES!!!

Simply tie some white tissue paper around the lolly pop and secure into place with some black wired cord. Fray the ends to create a rustic look. using a black fine liner draw in some eyes to make them really GHOSTLY!

## WITCHIES!

Wrap the Gummy bear/Smarties packs individually with white tissue paper, thread black ribbon through the white ribbon to keep it in place. Punch holes in the little pictures (from the digi kit) thread the ribbon through and tie 2/3 times to secure.
