



Decopatch Stationary



Materials & Tools:

- Decopatch Paper
- Decopatch Glue
- Decopatch Hog Bristle Brush
- Decopatch Embellishments
- Gold Acrylic Paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors

To alter the stapler:

Using decopatch paper, tear small squares and cover the top section of the stapler. Make sure that the paper overlaps and goes underneath all edges for a neat finish. You can either cover the complete top, or on the stapler I used, there was a raised section - this I left plain.

Once the Decopatch has dried, paint the raised area on the top of your stapler, and add Decopatch gem embellishments.



To alter the pen and pencil:

Tear small pieces of the Decopatch paper. Cover the pen or pencil finishing neatly at the nib of the pen. For the end of the pen and pencil, make sure your paper goes over the end and using more Decopatch glue, fold it over the end and glue it in place. Once dry this will dry hard. You will be able to use a sharpener on your pencil as normal.

For the pen, paint your lid in a co-ordinating colour to finish the look.

You can alter lots of stationary items in this way. You could even Decopatch a tin pencilcase for your stationary to be kept in.
