

## Key Rack



You will need:-



A chipboard base (I got mine from [www.DieCutDreams.co.uk](http://www.DieCutDreams.co.uk))

Assorted papers of your choice (I used A Proper Gentleman by Graphic 45)

Tim Holtz Distress Inks

Pack of 2 Album Posts available from most Scrapbooking shops

Mod Podge or varnish

Flower punches

Some buttons

What to do:-

1. Using your chipboard base as a stencil, draw round and cut out the shape required from your chosen paper.
2. Stick the paper to your chipboard base and allow to dry.

3. Ink the edges with distress inks



4. Paint the whole piece with Mod Podge or Varnish to seal and protect. I used a gloss to add texture.
5. While the Mod Podge is drying, punch some flowers out of co-ordinating papers and coat with Mod Podge or Varnish. Leave to dry.



6. Punch holes at the required points on your chipboard base and attach your Album Posts.
7. Assemble your flowers and attach to your chipboard base
