

Paper Christmas Tree



Materials & Tools:

- A3 piece of cream card
- 3 different papers (red Patterned paper, sheet music & book pages)
- masking tape
- paper trimmer
- compass
- double sided tape
- scissors

Instructions:

Draw a semi-circle on the cream card using a compass. The radius of the circle should be 21cm.

Wrap the semi-circle to create a cone and stick in place using plenty of masking tape to give you your basic tree shape.

Cut the 3 papers you chose into strips – the largest 2 x 6cm. These strips should reduce in size the further you get up the tree.

Starting at the bottom of the tree, stick a row of double sided tape a few centimetres up the tree. Curl the paper strips around a pencil or pen and stick them in a row around the tree.

Repeat the last step all the way up the tree.

At the top, cut a semi circle from two of the papers, one slightly larger than the other. Stick these in place around the top of the tree to finish it.
