

Egyptian Decoupage Card



You will need:

- Kanban Egyptian King Decoupage Sheet
- Kanban Egyptian Hieroglyphics Card
- Kanban Egyptian Papyrus Card
- A5 Blank White Card and Envelope
- Silicone Glue
- Double Sided Tape
- Scissors
- Paper Trimmer

To create the card:

1. Cut out the 4 decoupage panels. One will be the background for the decoupage.

2. From the second panel, cut out head dress, cut off the shoulder section. Trim up the sides of the neck so that you can shape the neck down the the base level. Stick this layer to the base layer using silicone glue.



3. From the third panel, cut out the face, top section of the head dress and beard. Curve the top of this piece down so that the top of the head dress is level with the second layer.

4. From the fourth panel, cut out the face and animal piece. Curve the face to give it shape and stick as the final layer using silicone glue.

5. Cut the front of he black card in half at a vertical angle so that the top is narrower than the bottom.

6. Flip the piece of card you just removed so that the bottom is wider. Cover with the Papyrus card leaving an extra section on the right so you can use is to attach to the right of the card creating a gatefold card.

7. Cover the left section of the card with the hieroglyphics card. Add the blue and gold hieroglyphics border from the decoupage sheet about two thirds down across the width of the entire card.

8. Cut a piece of the Papyrus card slightly larger than the decoupage and mount the decoupage in the centre. Mount this onto the centre of the card – ensuring that you only stick it to the left side of the card.

You can add a greeting to the card to make it extra special or use it as a cover to create your own Egyptian themed mini book.

There are many other papers, cards, stickers and decoupage sheets in the new Kanban Egyptian range to add your create touch to.
