

# Desk Calendar

Create this simple desk calendar – an ideal Christmas gift.

*You will need:*  
Mounting board  
2 sheets of patterned paper  
A piece of co-ordinating cardstock  
½m of ribbon  
2 paper flowers  
mini bulldog clip  
3 large brads  
Crop-a-dile Big Bite  
Paper trimmer  
craft knife  
Cuttlebug Machine  
Harmony Cuttlebug Alphabet Dies

## *Instructions:*

1. Cut your mounting board so that you have 2 pieces – 14 x 21cm.
2. Put double sided tape around the edges of one side of your mounting board pieces. Stick these face down onto the back of your main patterned paper – leaving a 3mm gap between the 2 pieces.
3. Trim the patterned paper so that you have one piece with your mounting board stuck to. Fold this along the centre – using the gap as a hinge in your calendar.
4. Cut a piece of your second patterned paper so that it is 21 x 5cm.
5. Stick a piece of ribbon along the length of this patterned paper and stick the ends onto the back. Stick this in place on your calendar.
6. Cut a piece of your first patterned paper 4 x 10cm. Back this onto your cardstock and trim, leaving a small border. Stick this in place on your calendar.
7. Using your Cuttlebug and alphabet dies, cut out the numbers '2009' and stick these in place.
8. Using your Big Bite set to the 3/16<sup>th</sup> hole, punch a hole towards the top. Put a brad through the back of your bulldog clip and fasten to your calendar through the hole.
9. Punch 2 more holes in the calendar in the bottom left and use to attach your paper flowers.

You can change the paper flowers for any other embellishments you may have.
