



Captivating Charms

The charms would add that little extra special touch to any bag, phone or craft project.

Daisy Handbag Charm

you will need ...

- 1 trigger clasp
- 2 jump rings
- 1 eye pin
- 1 ceramic daisy charm
- 4 ceramic washers



1. Take the daisy charm and a jump ring. Open the jump ring and attach the daisy charm. Close the jump ring.



2. Open the loop of the eye pin. Close the loop of the eye pin and add the washers.



3. Trim off the excess wire of the eye pin and turn a loop. Open another jump ring and attach the eyepin to the clasp.



Phone Charms

You will need...

- Phone charm cord
- 3 beads
- 1 jump ring
- 1 head pin
- a few seed beads

Thread your 3 beads onto a head pin.

If the holes in the beads are too large add a seed bead to stop the head pin slipping through the hole in the bead.

Turn a loop in the end of the head pin.





Open a jump ring and thread it through the loop in the head pin.

Add the loop on the phone charm cord.

Close the jump ring.



Flower Handbag Charm

You will need...

- 1 silver coloured flower charm
- 3 glass beads
- 1 eye pin
- 2 headpins
- 1 trigger clasp
- 3 jump rings

Thread the largest bead onto an eye pin, trim off the excess wire & turn a loop.

Thread the two other beads onto headpins, trim off the excess wire & turn a loop in each headpin.





Open a jump ring & attach it to the flower charm.

Thread the bottom loop of the eye pin onto the jump ring.

Close the jump ring.

Open a jump ring & attach it to the other end of the eye pin.
Close the jump ring.

Open another jump ring & thread on the beads in the following order; a bead on a headpin, the bead on the eye pin (with charm) and the other bead on a headpin.

Add the loop of the trigger clasp and then close the jump ring.
