Picture Perfect



Supplies:

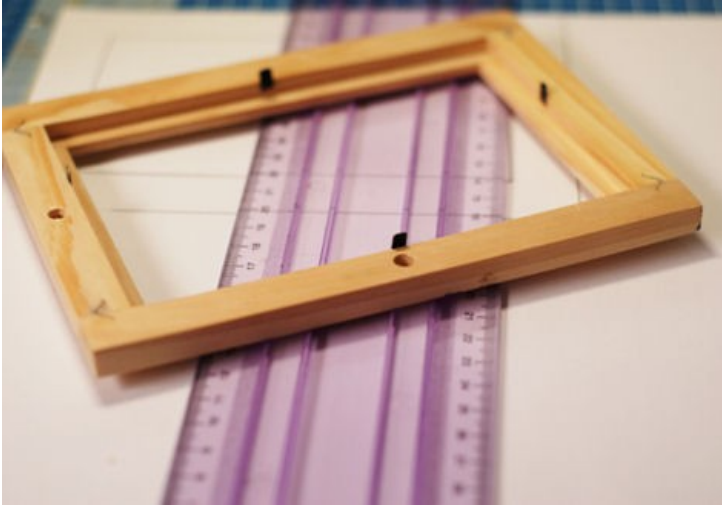
- Sheet of Junkitz Pop Rock Wide Stripes
- 3 large blooms in Orange, Pink and Black (I used junkitz)
- Various buttons in Pink, Orange and yellow
- Sandpaper
- Ink (optional)
- A wooden picture frame to hold 6" x 4" photo
- 1 6" x 4" photo

Tools:

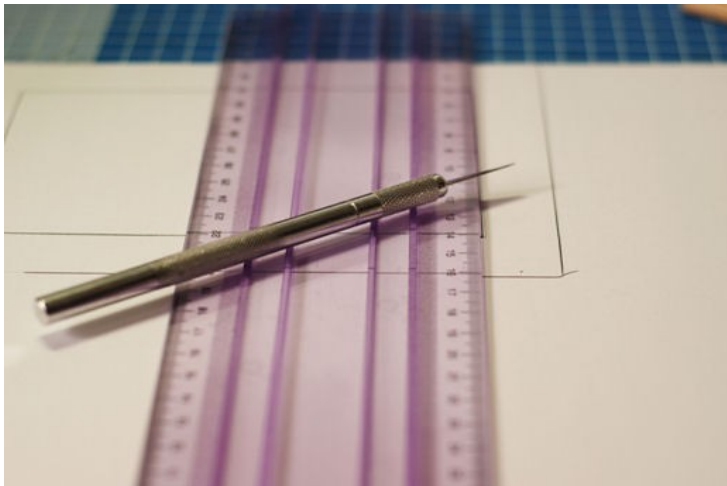
- Craft Knife
- Craft mat
- Pencil
- Double sided tape/Herma and PVA glue

Instructions:

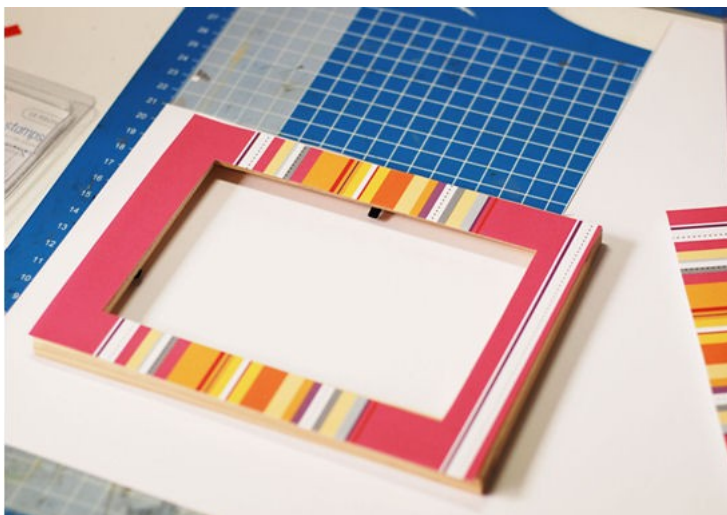
1. Take your picture frame and place onto the wrong side of your pattern paper and trace around.



2. Using your craft knife, cut the middle piece out first and then cut the outer shape.



3. Place your cut out frame onto your picture frame and adhere using double sided tape or herma.



4. Sand the edges for a neat finish and ink if you wish
5. Add your three blooms into the top right hand corner and add a button to the centre of the blooms
6. Have fun decorating your frame with lots of different shapes and colours of buttons
7. Add your photo and sit back and enjoy!

Ideas:

Why not try die cut flowers instead of buttons or add doodles to the edge of the frame for an up to date and funky look.

You can play around with colours and patterned papers to create a frame that co-ordinates perfectly with your photograph.
