

## Nestabilities Mini cards & Easel card

**What you will need to complete the Project:**



Scraps of plain card and patterned papers

Nestabilities

Stamped images or card toppers

Die Cutting machine

Embellishments

Bone folder

Scoring board (optional)

Basic Craft kit, foam pads

**Instructions:**



Score and fold a piece of plain card. Cut with the Nestabilities to make a card base, overlapping the edge of the card with the chosen shape.



Cut a piece of patterned paper using the same size Nestabilities shape and a topper to decorate the card.



Affix the patterned paper and topper to the front of the card using strong adhesive being careful to line up the scallops or chosen shape with the card base.

To make an easel card, follow step 1 for the basic card.



Score and fold through the middle of the front of the card base. Cut another shape from matching card.



Cut 2 smaller shapes from patterned paper and cut out a topper and a sentiment to be raised on foam pads. This will act as the the stopper for your easel card.



Add strong double sided tape to the bottom of the scored card front.



Assemble the layers and decorate the card, adding your sentiment on foam pads to hold the card in place when opened.
