SUPPLIES

Holiday papers
30inches of thin ribbon
Glitter
Beads (optional)

Tools

Double sided tape/Herma and PVA glue
Scalloped circle and square punch
Small flower punch
Hole punch

Instructions



- Punch 6 scalloped shapes in 2 contrasting papers
- Score and fold in half, either length ways or width ways
- Glue 3 folded shapes together, and the other 3 shapes, so you have 2 pairs
- Now add a strip of double sided tape down the middle of one set
- Fold your ribbon in half and stick to the double sided tape
- Add glue and sandwich the ribbon in-between
- Punch 2 paper flowers and hole punch in the middle
- Now add a paper flower or bead to the top and bottom by threading thorough the ribbon
- Finally add glitter, buttons or sequins if you wish, hang on your tree and admire!

Ideas

- This project is so quick and easy, even the children can join in, let them have fun with glitter glues and sequins!
- Add beads to the ribbon for an elegant finish
