

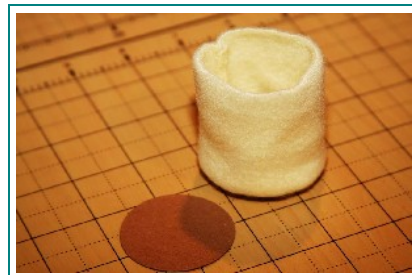
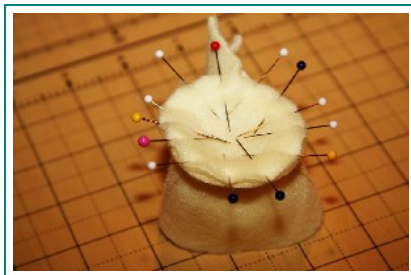
'A House on the Hill' Pin Cushion

Materials & Tools:

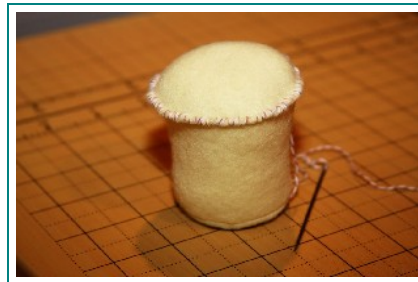
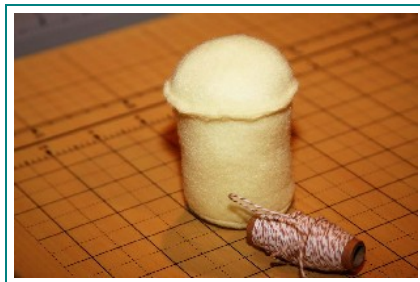
Felt
Heavy Cardstock
1.75" circle punch
Thread in coordinating colours
Flowers
Filling
Basic Sewing Tools
Decorative Pins
Flowers



1. Cut a 2" felt circle for your base of the hill. Then cut a strip of 5.5" long strip x 2.2" high. Pin the strip around the circle and stitch. Then stitch along the height to close the back of what will be the hill for your house.

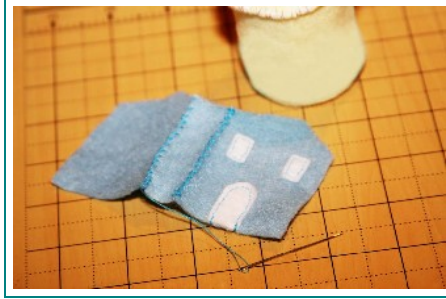
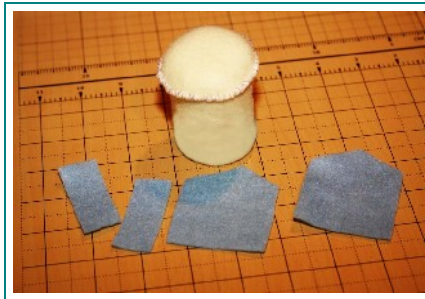


2. This is what it should look like once you are done. Punch out your circle out of heavy stock and insert at the base of your hill. This will help your hill stand straight up once filled.
3. Fill your hill. Next cut out another circle. This time 2.2" in diameter. Stitch this to the top of your hill. I just hand stitched it with a decorative thread. The pictures below show what it should look like.



4. Now we are ready to cut and assemble the house. It is super easy and what you will

need to cut is 2 sides about 3/4" wide x 2.2", your roof top 3/4" wide x 6" long tall. The front and back of the house is 2" wide x 2.4" tall. Hand stitch with decorative thread.



5. Cut out your windows and door and hand stitch on. Fill with down and stitch your house to the hill.



6. Hot glue a pretty garden on to the hill and add decorative pins as chimney smoke and part of the garden.

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
