Halloween Candy Cone

SUPPLIES

KI Memories Holiday Collection
½ Metre of ribbon
Making Memories velvet Halloween stickers
Tissue paper
Eyelets x 2

Tools

Craft Knife
Craft mat
Pencil
Double sided tape/Herma and PVA glue
Hole punch
Fancy edge scissors

Instructions

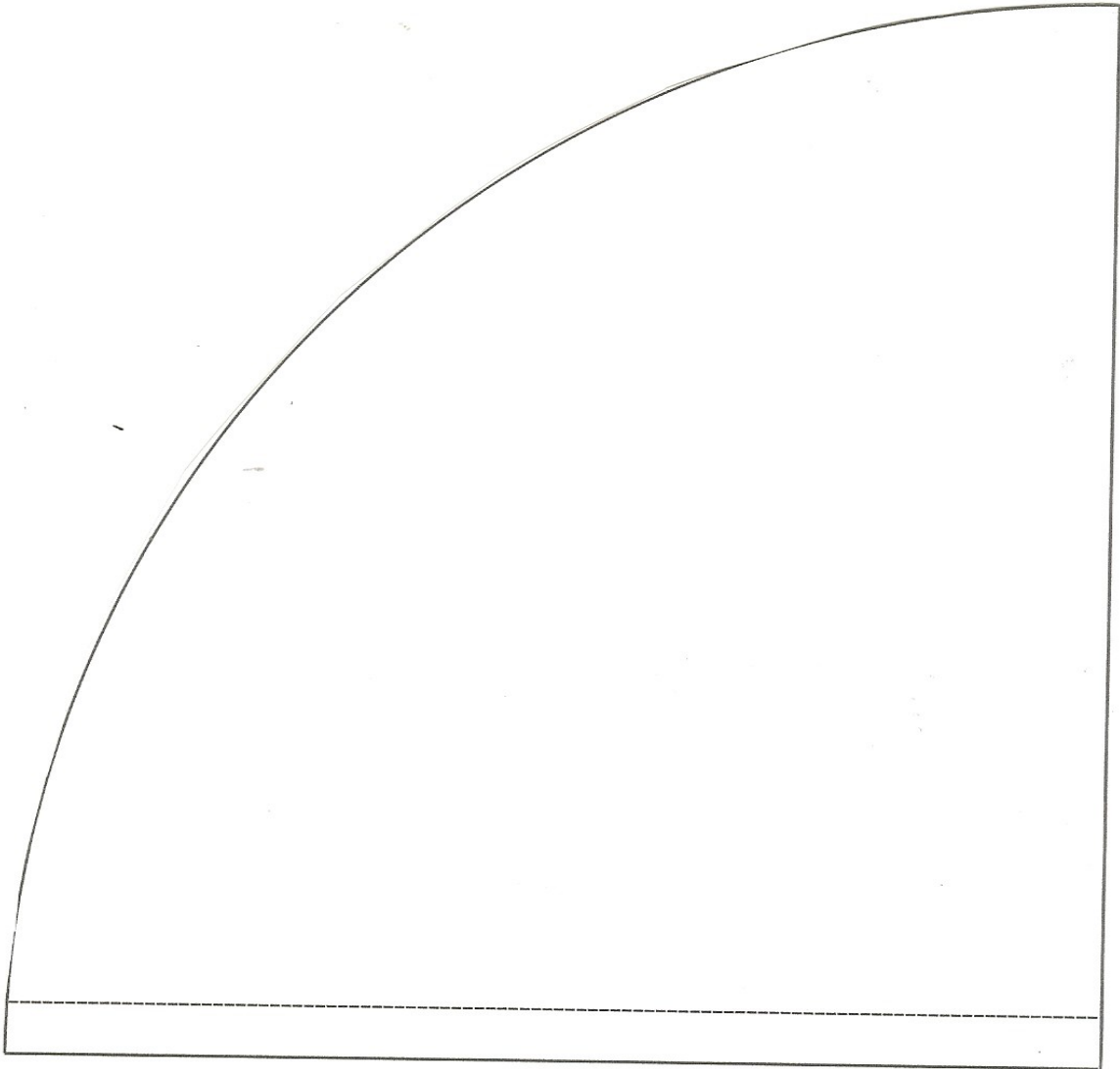


- Using the template provided cut out using a craft knife or scissors the straight edge.
- Use decorative scissors to cut the curved edge
- At this point I decorated my cone with two strips of coordinating papers and added “boo” velvet sticker
- Make 2 holes opposite each other and add eyelets
- Score the fold line and add double sided tape to the fold and adhere to the opposite side to form a cone
- Tie ribbon through the holes and fill with tissue paper
- Finally fill with sweets!!!!

- Why not use these candy cones for Halloween favors at your party
- These candy cones would look pretty sitting on your Christmas tree
