



## Mini Card and Envelopes

You will need:

- ★ Cricut Machine
- ★ Doodlecharms Cartridge
- ★ Card of your choice
- ★ Small pieces of patterned paper
- ★ Double-Sided Tape
- ★ Scissors



Instructions:

- ➔ Set the Cricut Machine to 4" and cut out the envelope shape from the Doodlecharms cartridge onto the card of your choice. To cut the envelope you will need to press 'Shift' and then select the card button.
- ➔ Leaving the Cricut set at 4", cut out the blank card shape from the same card as your envelope.



- ➔ To cut the front of the card, select the 'Card' function on the top left. This should light up. Then select which shape you would like to cut out of the bottom of the card. The ones used in this example are 'reindeer', 'party hat' and 'ladybug'.
- ➔ Cut a piece of the patterned paper so that it is big enough to cover the shape you have cut out of your card.
- ➔ Stick the patterned paper behind the shape and stick the blank card at the back using double sided tape.
- ➔ Score the envelope and use double sided tape to stick the flaps in place.

You can add other decoration and embellishments to your cards. You can use them on gifts, flowers or just as a quirky gift.
