



Wine Bottle Holder

Materials:

Natural Gift Bag
Golden Rod 4" Angel Bloom
Muted Dress it Up Big Buttons
Doodlebug Orange Ribbon
Naked Chipboard Label
Turquoise cardstock
Turquoise embroidery thread
Black doodling pen
Orange fabric paint pen
Black rub-on transfer greeting

Tools:

Pencil
Scissors
Craft knife
Glue
Needle

Instructions:

1. Glue your naked chipboard label to the turquoise card stock. Put this to one side to dry.
2. Sew your flower and button onto the natural gift bag using the embroidery thread. You will need to hold your button and flower carefully whilst you sew it in place.
3. Once dry, cut your chipboard label out and cut out the two holes in either end.
4. With your black pen, draw a border around the edge of the label and around the holes.
5. Place your rub-on transfer greeting to the label.



6. Cut a piece of ribbon that is almost twice the width of the label. Sew the label and ribbon to the gift bag with embroidery thread as shown.

7. Draw out 'wine' onto your bag lightly with pencil to give you a guide. Go over this with the fabric paint pen.



You can change the wine to any other drink that you want to put into your gift bag. You can also change the greeting on the label to a name or just a generic 'Happy Birthday'.
