

Halloween Project – Stage One!

Spooky bunting and party invitation

Ingredients required:

Orange, black and white cardstock

OHP paper for party invitation

Spooky patterned paper

Orange ribbon

Black string

Pva glue

White gel pen



Bunting

- **Cut out six triangles from the orange cardstock (at a size to suit you)**
- **Cut out six various size triangles from the black cardstock**
- **Adhere the black triangles onto the orange triangles and using your white gel pen make a pattern edge on the black card.**
- **Cut out 3 ghost shapes from your white cardstock and 3 pumpkin shapes from your patterned paper (I used the free templates from [Papercraft Inspirations](http://www.papercraftinspirationsmagazine.co.uk) which you can download from here www.papercraftinspirationsmagazine.co.uk)**
- **Punch two holes at the top of each triangle and thread your black string through to hang.**
- **Finished, as easy as that 😊**



Party Invitation

- **Cut and score your OHP paper to the required size**
- **Using the pumpkin template again adhere to black then white cardstock and place in the centre of the front of your card (white card cut to 70mm x 70mm)**
- **In the middle of the card using black cardstock place a 70mm x 70mm again in the middle, you can then use this to write your party details on or just use this a Happy Halloween card**
- **Tie ribbon to the edge of the card**
- **Again finished, not much time taken at all.**

Pop back for the next instalment of your Halloween celebrations where I show you how to cover a gift box (like the Christmas box made previously) and make some cupcake toppers ☺

Remember you don't have to go out and buy all new cardstock for your projects, you can use odd scraps to make any projects come alive. Use up your old papers first before buying new supplies.
