

Photo Memories Bracelet



You will need...

- picture frame charms
- hearts/ beads
- chain
- head pins
- toggle clasp
- jump rings
- decoupage glue

Instructions:

I have used three of my favourite photos of my son as a young child. You can use as many as you wish but you will need to adjust the quantities of charms and beads accordingly.

Decide which photos you wish to use and print them – it's trial & error getting the right size to fit into the picture frame charms. I use a word document, insert the photos and then resize them by dragging on the corner of the photo.



Glue the pictures into the picture frame charms with decoupage glue, covering the picture with glue too. Allow to dry.

Cut the chain to your required bracelet length – minus 2 cm (to allow for the toggle clasp).

Attach the toggle clasp to each end of the chain with jump rings.

Put all the heart/beads on head pins and turn a loop (if you can do wrapped loops this will make them more secure but it isn't necessary).



Put the bracelet on your work bench and then lay out the photo charms and heart beads at regular intervals. By doing this you can re-position them until you are happy with the order.



Attach the photo charms and hearts to the bracelet with jump rings.

You can use as many hearts and beads as you like and maybe some heart shaped charms too – the more you add the chunkier the bracelet will be. This bracelet has a fabulous vintage feel.

Don't immerse this bracelet in water as the photo charms won't be completely waterproof.

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
