

Dangly Chain & Charm Necklace



This project is a great way of using left over beads and charms.

I'm not going to give you specific quantities as the project is intended for you to adapt to your own requirements. It would be a great necklace for the Christmas party – choose a colour scheme to match your outfit.

You will need some basic jewellery making skills or use my jewellery making techniques project http://www.easycraftprojects.net/Projects/6970basic_jewellery_techniques.pdf

You will need

chain
Tiger tail beading wire
crimps
assorted beads – approx 50
assorted charms – approx 10
jump rings
clasp
tag or extender chain
head pins
eye pins

Instructions



Thread your beads onto head pins and eye pins – attach the charms to the eye pins by either opening the eye pin or with a jump ring.

Turn a loop in the end of the wire – if you can make a wrapped loop then this will be more secure, but it is not necessary as long as you make sure the loop is fully closed.

Cut a few strand of chain. Attach a charm to the end of some of the strands of chain with a jump ring.

Thread the beaded head pins, eye pins and strands of chain onto the tigertail with a small bead between each one. You might find it easier to lay everything out beforehand.



Depending on how long you want your necklace to be cut two lengths of chain.

Attach each end of the beaded tigertail to the chain with crimps. Make sure the crimps are secure by pulling gently on the necklace before cutting off the excess tigertail.



Finish the necklace by adding a clasp and tag or extender chain to each end of the chain with jump rings.
