



## Altered Soup Can

This fun altered soup can has so many usages!

### SUPPLIES

1 large tomato soup can (preferably Heinz tomato soup!)  
Scenic Route holiday papers  
Felt flowers  
Buttons  
Chipboard flower  
Ribbon

### Tools

Paper trimmer  
Double sided tape/Herma and glue dots



## Instructions

- Trim a sheet of paper 17cm and adhere to the can using double sided tape
  - Trim paper 5 cm and add to the center of your covered tin
  - Next cut a strip 2 cm and glue to the centre of the last strip
  - For the handle cut a strip 3cm, and add a length of ribbon down the centre. Attach to the inside of the can
  - Cover a large chipboard flower and add buttons to the centre. Add to the centre of your can.
  - I have placed buttons around my can, you can add jewels, flowers, an assortment of embellishments!

- Finally I covered 2 more large chipboard flowers, added felt flowers and buttons for a layered look and attached to each side of the can. Finished decorating the handle with more felt flowers and buttons
  - Now fill with you paintbrushes and pens, place on your desk and admire!

## Ideas

- Use your soup can as a pen holder
- Why not plant some house bulbs direct into the can, or add a plant ☺ would look so pretty on your kitchen window sill. Just don't add the handle
- Why not fill with inspiring quotes.
- Would make a lovely gift filled with tissue paper and filled with smellies
