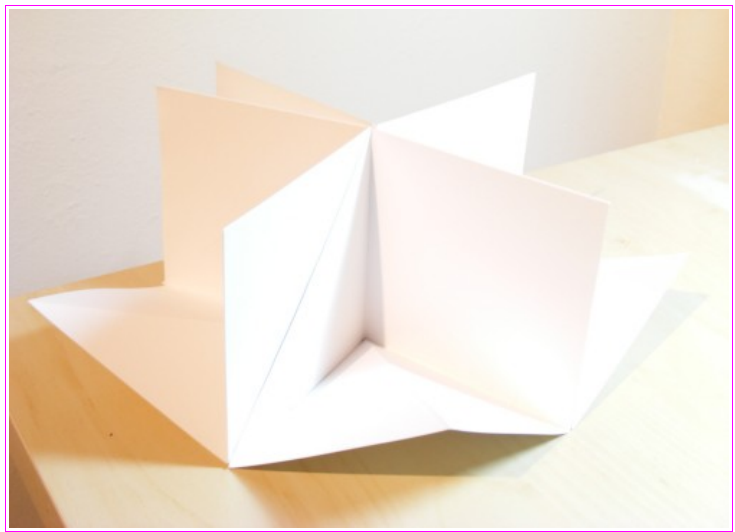


Dynamic Book Card

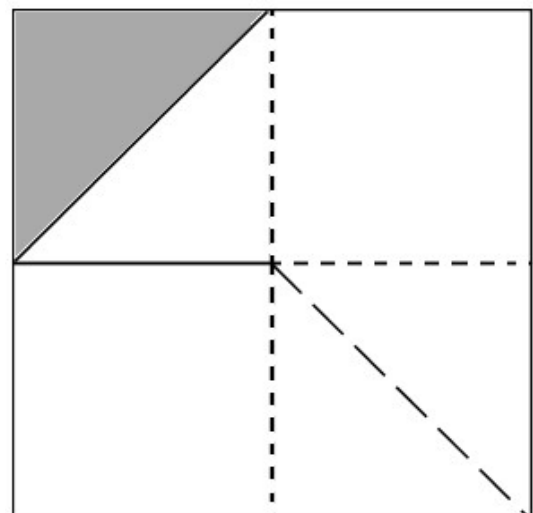
You will need:

4 Sheets A4 Card in a matching colour
Scissors
Paper Trimmer
Pencil
Ruler
Scorer
Double Sided Tape



Instructions:

1. Cut a piece of the A4 card to 20 x 20cm. Repeat this with all the card so you have 4 square pieces of card.
2. Split the squares into 4 equal sections of 10 x 10cm as shown in the diagram.
3. In the top left square and bottom right square draw diagonal lines as shown in the diagram.
4. Cut off the outer triangle on the top left. Cut along the horizontal line which goes from the left side to the middle.
5. Score all the other lines.
6. Fold the two triangles in the bottom right so that they fold into the two squares.
7. Fold the single triangle into the section and using double sided tape stick the side closest to the fold and a small piece of double sided tape (no more than 1cm), stick the triangle to create a two sides and a base. This triangle can then act as a pocket.
8. Repeat this process of cutting, scoring and folding on the other pieces of card and stick them back to back. This should create an opening book card with 4 sections.

Ideas:

You can decorate with many papers, toppers, embellishments and so much more.

Attach ribbon to the front of the card and cover with a topper. This will allow the card to be tied ready to be opened by the receiver.

The pockets within the card can be used to hold photographs, tickets and more.
