



Valentine's Heart Basket & Card



To complete the Project, you will need:

Mirkwood designs heart basket template (available at <http://www.ruthannzaroff.com/mirkwooddesigns/heartbasket.htm>)

12x12 sheet red card

Scraps of polka dot card

Gingham Ribbon

Eyelet Setter and Eyelets

Heart template or Heart Nestabilities and Die cutter

Stamped image and greeting

Colouring pens or pencils

Black chalk ink

Double sided tape or glue gun

Lace

Fabric or paper flowers

Instructions:

1. Download the basket template and resize to the desired size on your PC. Print directly onto red card. Cut out and score along lines. Ink edges and folds.



2. Stick lace to inside top edges of basket with glue gun or double sided tape. Make a hole with a punch or eyelet setter for handles. Glue the bag together and add ribbon handle.



3. Line the inside of the bag with coordinating paper to hide raw edges of lace and decorate the front.



- Cut a card blank in the shape of a heart using heart template or heart shaped Nestabilities.



- Cut another heart from red card and add lace around the edge in the same way as the basket. Stick lace edged heart to the front of the card blank taking care to line up both hearts to hide raw edges of lace. Decorate the front of the card with another heart, a stamped and coloured image and flowers.



- All that is left to do is to fill the basket with Yummy chocolates or a special gift for your Valentine!
