

Quick & Easy

EASTER CARDS



The cards are all made using the latest range of Anita's Outline Stickers from Docrafts. They are simple to make – perfect for the Create a Card Appeal.

Materials:

A6 cream blank cards & envelopes

Various coloured papers

Anita's Outline Stickers

- Easter Egg & Bunnies -Silver
- Daffodils – Light Yellow

Silver

Ribbon

Double sided tape

Sticky foam squares

Tools:

Scissors

Paper Trimmer

Craft Knife

To create this card, cut a piece of pale green paper to cover the bottom half of the card. Stamp the floral design down the the right hand side of the card using the black ink pad. Cut a strip of yellow corrugated card and stick across the bottom of the card. Add a piece of yellow paper to the top right of the card and stick the large yellow daffodil outline sticker in the very top right. Add the greeting by cutting it from the border outline sticker.

CHOCOLATE EGGS CARD

To create this card, cut three eggs from the outline sticker sheet. Stick these across a thick strip of pale green paper and carefully cut around them so that the green only covers the border part of the eggs. Then stick these onto brown paper and cut around the complete shape. Layer these using double sided tape and sticky foam pads onto three coloured strips of paper across the top of the card. Add the 'Happy Easter' sticker border across the centre of the card.



YELLOW DAFFODILS CARD

To create this card, cut a piece of cream textured card that is slightly taller than the daffodils outline sticker and about 3/8 the width of the card. Back this onto green paper creating a border. Mount this onto the card using double sided tape. Add the daffodil outline sticker, a 'Happy Easter' greeting and attach a piece of pale orange or yellow ribbon across the bottom of the card using double sided tape (overlapping is slightly around the edges to keep a neat look to the front of the card).
