

Christmas Mini Journal

Supplies:

Christmas Scrapbook Papers (I'm using Doodlebug)
Various alphabets - stickers & rub-ons
Ribbons & buttons
Cardstock
Chipboard sheet/Mounting board
Book ring
Usual crafting tools and adhesives



Instructions:

To make the covers, cut two squares from your chipboard or mounting board to 4" x 4". Round the corners using a heavy duty corner-rounder. Decorate the cover as you wish. I used red mounting board but you may need to cover the chipboard with paper or paint it. I stuck a piece of patterned paper 3.5" x 3.5" to each cover. On the front I stuck a piece of ribbon vertically, added the title, year and a little star button.

The pages are also cut to 4" x 4" with rounded corners. I have cut them from cardstock so that they are ready to add your journalling and decorate quickly during the festive season.

You can build up your book however you like, you may wish to create a page for each day or you may decide just to record certain things during the festive season. You may print small index photos to add onto your pages with some journalling, or you may decide to print your photo as a full page in your mini journal.

This is your book and it is so versatile so that you can record things however feels best for you.
