

Flower Pot Using Flower Soft

Flower Soft is one of the newest materials on the market. Simple to use, Flower Soft can be used to create realistic flowers and plants. Following these simple steps you can create your own Flower Pot.

You will need:

Flower Soft, wire, tacky PVA glue, ceramic half pot, wire cutters, piece of foam or plasticine and a container.

1. Cut the pieces of wire into pieces at least 2 inches in length.
2. Tip the flower soft into a larger container to give you more space to work.
3. Cover the top quarter to a third of the wire in the tacky glue.
4. Hold the wire over the container and sprinkle the Flower Soft over the wire so that it is covered.
5. Stick the wire into the foam or plasticine and leave to dry.
6. Do this for about 10-14 stems depending on the size of your pot.
7. Once dry, measure the lengths of the stems against the size of your pot. You may need to trim them down to fit properly.
8. Put a large blob of the tacky glue into the bottom of the pot and push your stems into the put so that they are in place. Leave to dry.



This pot is ideal for use on the front of cards or many other crafting projects. For an extra touch, add glitter to the stems. To do this, sprinkle the stems with fine glitter after you have covered them in Flower Soft before you leave them to dry.
